

God's Will: How to Prayerfully Seek It (Pt. 2)

Verses to assist you in praying concerning the will of God for your life:

Psalm 5:8; Psalm 25:4-5, 12-14; Psalm 27:11, 14; Psalm 143:8

Make these Scriptures your personal prayers concerning God's will for your life to guide you specifically.

God says, *Ask and it shall be given you, seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you.*

Ask God to make His way for you **so plain, so straight**, and **so simple** that you cannot possibly miss it, or **be deceived by your enemies** (the world, your flesh, the devil).

- 1) **Psalm 5:8**, **Lead** me, O LORD, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face.
 - **Lead** = let your righteousness guide me (do what is right-according to God and the Bible).

- 2) **Psalm 25:4-5**, **Shew** me thy ways, O LORD; **teach** me thy paths. Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I **wait** all the day.
 - **Shew** = make obvious by observation and instruction
 - **teach** = inspire, motivate, instruct me concerning your paths (the worn paths that godly people have traveled, paths of integrity: morally, ethically, and doctrinally)
 - **wait** = I look to you for approval; I will patiently wait for your lead.
 - Vs. 12-14, *What man is he that feareth (acknowledges His Lordship, obeys) the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD (God will share His thoughts with you when He doesn't for others) is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant (His promises).*

- 3) **Psalm 27:11**, **Teach** me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a **plain** path, because of **mine enemies**.
 - **Teach** = different word than Psalm 24:4-5, means to point me in the right direction, toward the target
 - **plain** = just, righteous path (make it obvious to me)
 - **mine enemies** = The world, the flesh, and the devil can deceive us.

- 4) **Psalm 143:8**, **Cause me to hear** thy lovingkindness in the morning;

*for in thee do I trust: **cause me to know** the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee.*

- **Cause me to hear**

= Help me to understand, to be discerning, to listen intently and obey. Lord, Divinely assist me.

= Help me to learn by observing the example of godly believers and by learning from the counsel of your Word and from the counsel of godly spiritual teachers.

- **cause me to know**

= Give me assurance that comes from your Word, your Holy Spirit, godly counsel and inner peace.
